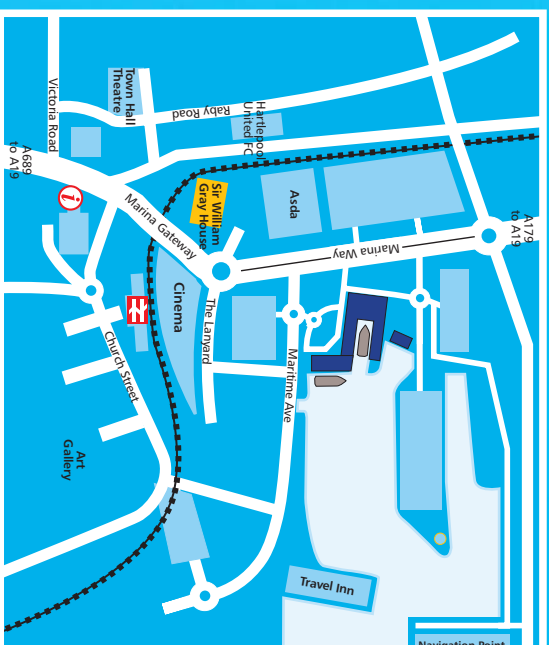
NEEMARA is a new and exciting maritime resource established in 2006 by the Nautical Archaeology Society North-East (NAS NE), with English Heritage grant funding.
