Prompts

- Signs?
 - o Are there signs painted on walls, like graffiti? What about signs hanging in front of shops? How do they compare to advertisements today?
- Methods of transport?
 - o Are there cars? If not, what kind of transport is visible?
- Clothing?
 - o Does the clothing look different or the same as clothing now?
- New buildings?
 - o Are there buildings in your photo that aren't in your historic photo?
- Buildings or decoration disappeared?
 - o Are there buildings in your historic photo that aren't in your photo? Are the buildings still there, but with different decoration?
- Change of use?
 - o What are the buildings being used for? Are they still being used for that purpose?
- Shop fronts?
 - o How has the decoration at the front of shops changed or stayed the same? Do they have different windows and displays?
- Street lights?
 - o Are there street lights? How have they changed?
- Chimneys?
 - o Are there chimneys? Do they look the same or different?
